

ORDINANCE 1202-2012

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF MOUNTAINSIDE AND THE MOUNTAINSIDE P.B.A. LOCAL 126 FOR THE PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2011 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2013

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mountainside is desirous of entering into a Collective Bargaining Agreement with the P.B.A. Local 126 for the purpose of establishing salary and benefits for the period of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the parties have determined to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Finance Officer has certified that sufficient funds are available for this contract for the current fiscal year.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mountainside, County of Union, State of New Jersey, that the appropriate Borough officials are hereby authorized to execute the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Borough of Mountainside and the Mountainside P.B.A. Local 126, for the period of January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2013 as follows:

C. All Emergency Medical Technician (E.M.T.) certified police officers shall receive an annual prorated stipend of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
